


6.2.1 - The institutional Strategic plan is effectively deployed

- Steps were undertaken by the university to maintain strict hygiene in the campus. All the precautions were undertaken to ensure health and hygiene among the stakeholders. Standard operating systems were issued time to time as and when issued by the governments.
- Similar to the previous academic year the university could not implement most of its plans due to the Covid-19 lockdown and related constraints.
- To conduct workshops/special lectures through online mode for research students on Research Methodology in all the faculties. To organize training to the young researchers on the applications of Statistical tools in research data analysis in all the subjects.
- To organize online programmes for the under-graduate teachers on curriculum design in various subjects of all the faculties. More emphasis will be given to update the syllabus in respective subjects with advanced aspects. Further, to advise the subject experts to highlight on the possible outcome of the complete syllabus if implemented in the preamble of the syllabus.
- To maintain the existing the high *h-index* and *i-10 index*.
- To organize National level Seminars/conferences through online in all the subjects on the current research trends.
- The university plans to strengthen its ICT facility and encourage teachers to promote online interactions with the students on their respective subject areas to keep the students updated. To advice teachers to develop e-content in their respective subjects to facilitate the Online mode of teaching. Further, to insist the teachers to record their online classes so that the recorded lectures may be shared with the students.
- To encourage the teachers to utilize e-resources available in the library and other public domains and also encourage the students to make use of the available resources.
- To encourage the students to utilize the Online resources such SWAYAM and MOOC portals to select opt and register for various courses through online mode and earn additional credits.
- To strengthen the facilities available in the hostels and maintain complete hygiene in view of the Covid-19 pandemic.
- To inform the teachers to give more emphasis for collaborative research with reputed research institutions in the state and the country.
- To advise the faculty members establish contacts with reputed research institutes in the country and the state to initiate collaborative research. Further, to direct the teachers to apply for major infrastructure grants such as DST-FIST, UGC-SAP, DBT-BUILDER etc.
- To Participate and maintain NIRF ranking of the University.
