The Workbook has been designed to make language learning simple and pragmatic. Exercises have been provided in every unit to make students work and practice. With an objective to make students self reliant in acquiring and mastering the skills of language, the Board of Studies has decided to allot 5 marks for the workbook in each semester from the academic year 2018-2019. 
