

Submissions must include title, abstract (about 250 words), keywords, author and affiliation with email address. The size of the paper should not

exceed 5000 words. The paper should not contain page numbers or any special headers or footers. The organizers consider plagiarism as a serious professional misconduct. All submissions are subjected for screening for plagiarism and when identified, the submission will be rejected.
