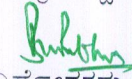

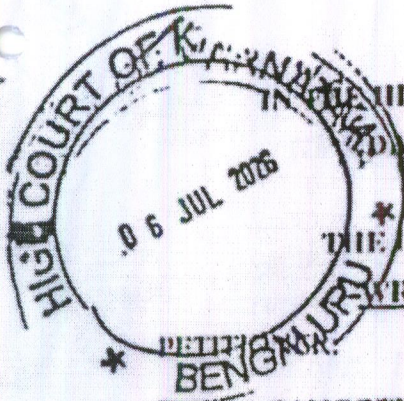

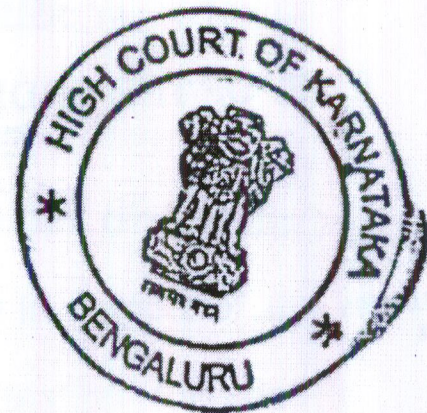

ORAL ORDER ON

I.A. Nos.1 and 2 of 2026

1. The petitioner has filed I.A. No.1 of 2026, stating that as per Order dated 24.03.2025, this Court has allowed the present students of the petitioner's Institution to participate in the examination to be conducted by respondent No.3 and also allowed fresh admissions for the further academic year. Accordingly, Kuvempu University has allowed the admission of students for the Academic Years 2023-24, 2024-25 and 2025-26.
2. Respondent No.3 has issued the exam challan for having received the examination fee in respect of II year, 3rd semester of B.Ed. examination for the Academic Year 2024-25. After receiving the examination fee, respondent No.3 generated the

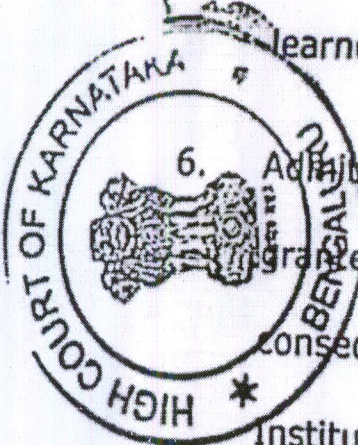
registration number in respect of the students to appear for the annual examination of Kuvempu University.

3. In this regard, respondent No.3 has supplied the answer books and the students appeared for the examination and thereafter, respondent No.3 announced the results of the students.

4. The petitioner-Institution requested the respondents to open the portal and log-in to UUCMS B.Ed. students and to consider the fresh admission for the Academic Year 2026-27 after collecting the necessary fee. The respondents did not consider the request. Hence, this application.

5. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the respondents.

6. Admittedly, this Court vide Order dated 24.03.2025 granted an interim order staying Annexure-A and consequently, allowing the students of the petitioner Institution to participate in the examination to be



conducted by respondent No.3 and also allowing fresh admission for further Academic Year.

7. Pursuant to the Interim order passed by this Court, the students of the petitioner-Institution appeared for the examination and thereafter, the respondent University has withheld the results.

8. Admittedly, the writ petition is pending. The matter requires consideration.

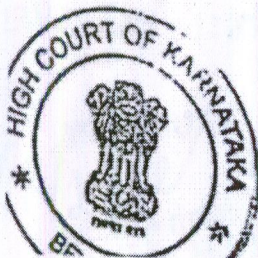
9. If the result of the students of the petitioner-Institution is held up, no purpose would be served. Therefore, if a direction is issued to the respondent-University in this regard, no injustice would be caused to the University.

10. In view of the above discussion, I pass the following:

ORDER

(I) I.A. Nos.1 of 2026 and 2 of 2026 are
allowed.

(II) Petitioner-Institution is permitted to
take fresh admissions for the



Academic Year 2026-27 after
collecting necessary fees;

(III) The respondents are directed to open the portal and login UUCMS of B.Ed. students, and, to announce the results of the students of the petitioner Institution in respect of Academic Year 2023-24 of III and IV semester students, and 2024-25 of I and II Semesters students of B.Ed.

(IV) The same is subject to the outcome of the writ petition;

Respondents are directed to webhost and disclose regarding the pendency of the writ petition in their website.

(VI) Neither the petitioner-Institution nor the students will claim any equity, in case the writ petition is dismissed.

(VII) The Interim order granted earlier to continue till the next date of hearing.
